## Code of conduct

### General

In all situations, both on-line and in person, members are expected to act in a reasonable and courteous manner towards others and to respect their rights, dignity and worth. Bullying, harassment, discrimination, victimisation, impersonation, defamation and causing offence to others are not acceptable. If directed at young, vulnerable or minority groups, such behaviour is even more reprehensible. Members should not condone or allow to go unchallenged, any form of misconduct, if witnessed.

### Events

Players are expected to behave in a manner which is not contrary to the integrity or reputation of the sport. This applies to all croquet-related activities from informal events, through to international events outside Croquet England's domain.

In tournaments, players are expected to participate in the spirit of friendship, solidarity and fair play, and comply with Croquet England Tournament Regulations (or other regulations relevant to the event) and all Croquet England Policies.
